WHAT WE ACCEPT

Kitchen– Tableware (plates, bowls, glasses, silverware) Pots, Pans, Cookie Sheets, Spatulas, Knives, Kitchen Towels, Kitchen Trash Cans, Measuring Cups etc.

Bath– Towels, Bathroom Rugs, Shower Curtains, Toilet Paper

Living Areas – Dinette Table and Chairs, Couches (regular & love seat), Living Room Chairs, Tables (end & coffee), Lamps (table & floor)

Bedroom- Metal Bed Frames (queen & twin only), Boxsprings (queen & twin), Mattress (queen & twin), Dressers, End Tables, Sheets (queen & twin), Blankets & Comforters, Pillows, Pillowcases

Appliances-Toaster, Microwave, Coffee Makers, Flat Screen TVs (small & medium), Fans

Household Goods- Cleaning Supplies, Brooms & Dustpans, Laundry Detergent, Area Rugs (4' x 6' max), Tools (screwdriver, hammer, pliers)

WHAT WE CANNOT ACCEPT

File Cabinets, Office Desks, Beds (other than queen and twin size), Sleeper Sofas, Mirrors, Bar Stools, Washers, Dryers, Air Conditioners, Entertainment Centers, Baby/Toddler Furniture, Toys, Clothing, Items in need of repair, Decorations

Human Dignity Standards – Please only consider donating items that you would still gladly give to family or friends. Everything must be in good working order. Nothing broken, ripped, dirty or stained.
